1. PRESENTATION.

By Order 684/2006, of February 14, the Advisor of Education of the Community of Madrid, (B.O.C.M number 52, 2 of March of 2006), agreed that the Faculty of Law of the University of Alcalá will have Official Programs of Postgraduate Courses: Master in Law “Master en Derecho” and Doctor of Law “Doctor en Derecho”, that will be ruled by the Real Decree “Real Decreto” 56/2005, of January 21st, that regulates all of the official university studies of Postgraduate Courses.

With the Master in Law the University of Alcalá implants a serious official Master’s degree, competitive and guaranteed by the experience and prestige of all the teaching staff of the Faculty of Law. The Faculty also is anticipated to the beginning of the European Space of Superior Education. This Official Masters in Law constitutes an Official Program of Postgraduate Courses, approved by the Community of Madrid, that is given under the system of credits ECTS.

The teaching quality, the wide offer of courses and specialized conference, the collaborating practices in companies and institutions, the well equipped and modern installations, a Faculty with excellent communications, and great public prices, makes this “Masters in Law” one of the top ten in legal specialization to national level.

C) PUBLIC TO WHOM GOES DIRECTED.

The Masters goes directed to the following groups:

- Spain Citizens and foreigners lawyers, that want to acquire specialized legal knowledge on different subjects, and want a practical formation that allows them a labour insertion (in offices of lawyers, legal cabinets in company, self-employed, in Public Administrations, etc.).
- Legal Professionals that need to update their knowledge.
- Legal Professionals interested in beginning in the legal investigation and elaborating a Doctoral Thesis.

D) STRUCTURE AND CREDITS.

The Masters in Law has one double modality. The Professional Master tries to facilitate the incorporation of students to the labour market or to update the knowledge of legal

professionals. The Master of Legal Research is necessary to be able to obtain the Doctor degree (PhD). Its structure is the following one:

a) Professional Master (90 credits ECTS).

1. Master Courses (54 credits): chosen of the listing courses.
2. Course of professional deontology (4 credits): obligatory.
3. Practices in companies (20 credits).
4. Memory of Master (12 credits).

b) Masters of Master of Legal Research: (60 credits ECTS).

1. Master Courses (36 credits): chosen of the listing courses.
2. Course of investigation methodology (4 credits): obligatory.
3. Dissertation "Tesina" (20 credits)

1. OBJECTIVE

a) Common objectives of the Master:

- Specialization of the jurist in certain law fields, indicated like specialties in the study plan, which demand on the formation market is very significant.
- Putting in practice the legal knowledge acquired in the Degree.
- To help to the development of skills and professional abilities in legal activities.

b) Objectives of the modality of a Professional Master:

- Allow the students to have the possibility of studding in other universities and institutions.
- Approach the students to the future labour, with a system of practices in companies and institutions.
- Formation in professional deontology.
- Evaluate the acquired knowledge throughout the Master, this consists in a final work defence (practice work), on some legal subject of the present time.

c) Objectives of the modality of Master of Legal Research.

- To consider the legal problems with more interest in the society and that need legal investigation.
- Allow the student to study in other universities in national and foreign institutions.
- Formation in investigation methodology.
- Specialization of the student in those courses that are special interest to them.
- Evaluation on the knowledge acquired throughout the Masters with the defense of a Dissertation "Tesina" or an original work of research on some legal subject of this times.

F) CONTENTS.

The courses, of four months are normally obligatory. This Master that has been proposal by the Community of Madrid making possible to obtain the Masters Degree with a certain specialty. To obtain the specialty is necessary to pass six courses of the itinerary (each one, like general rule, of 4.5 credits) and elaborate a Memory or Dissertation “Tesina” related to the specialty. Who does not fulfil this previous requirements, will be able to obtain the title of Master, but without the reference of specialization.

G) PRACTICAL DETAILS.

Communications:

Five minutes walking from the faculty of law to the train station “Cercanías RENFE” of Alcalá de Henares, it is also next to the terminal buses Continental-Auto, and to the former route “Nacional II”. Next to the Cuatro Caños square, in the historical center of Alcalá de Henares (Patrimony of the Humanity).

b) Date and schedule:

The academic course of the Master begins in 2006/2008. The classes will begin in October of 2006, divided periods of fourth months of 12 weeks. Who obtains the maximum number of credits allowed by the norm (60 annual credits ECTS) will have finished the Professional Master in March of 2008 and the Masters of Legal Research in June of 2007. The classes will be distributed, from Monday to Friday, in schedule in the afternoon, although some courses will be schedule in morning.

c) Prices and inscription:

The public prices are pending to be resolved by the Ministry of Education and Science and by the Community of Madrid (between 1000 and 2500 Euros).

d) Requirements of admission and documentation that must be contributed.

In agreement with the effective norm, to be admitted in the Official Masters of Law it is required:

- To be in possession of the Degree in Law (a title from spanish or foreign university).
- Exceptionally, to have passed the First Cycle of the Degree in Law, in which case will be necessary a Resolution of the University Director (Rector).

In this case requires a selection process, this will consist in:

- A evaluation of the academic file, as well as the formation and previous experience of the student.
- In the case of foreign titles could be valued the accomplishment of a Course on line of Spanish Law for Foreign Jurists of the Faculty of Law of the University of Alcalá:

- Accomplishment of a personnel interview.

The documentation that must be contributed is the following one:

- Photocopy updated and legible of the DNI (in the case of the Spanish citizens) or of passport or NIE (in the case of the foreign citizens).
- Certified photocopy of the title required for the access.
- Personal Academic certification with all the subjects passed with their respective qualifications (original or certified photocopy).
