The Law School is located in the Old Quarter of Alcalá de Henares, in the “Colegio Máximo de Jesuitas” building. It was built in the 17th Century and it is historically considered one of the main schools of the Jesuit order in Spain. Later, after being dismantled in 1836, it was converted into military barracks. In 1990 it reverted back into an educational facility to house the recent reestablished University of Alcalá. Our facility is located on “Calle Libreros,” and it includes a large educational building and an impressive historic church.

Access to the Law School is available by means of public transportation, being located very close to both the regional train station and an intercity bus station, which allows for an easy commute between Madrid and Alcalá de Henares, day and night. From “La Continental” located in the Avenida de America bus station, Madrid, you can take the 223 and 229 buses. Close to the Law School, there are also bus stops for most city buses within Alcalá de Henares.
