- Acquire strategies to stimulate student effort and promote their ability to learn by themselves and with others, and develop thinking and decision-making skills that facilitate autonomy, confidence and personal initiative.
- Develop and apply both group and personalised teaching methodologies adapted to the diversity of students.
- Design, execute and evaluate research projects in the classroom, in an autonomous way, determining the objectives of the project, the phases of its realization and the necessary resources.
- Participate in group discussions and activities related to English language teaching, developing autonomous and critical thinking.
- Plan, structure and carry out adequately and with some originality written work and oral presentations
 in English on topics related to the teaching of the language, transmitting ideas effectively and correctly.
- Search, obtain, process and communicate information (oral, printed, audiovisual, digital or multimedia) and apply it in the processes of teaching and learning English as a foreign language.
- Develop strategies to continue training as lifelong learning professionals through the use of appropriate literature, attending courses and conferences, conducting action-research projects, etc.
