



DOUBLE'S DEGREE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE UNIVERSITY OF GENOA

The University of Genoa, Genoa, Italy, hereinafter also referred to as UniGe, in the person of its pro-tempore legal representative, the Rector, Prof. Federico Delfino, acting on the basis of the provisions contained in Ministerial Decree n. 820 of 30th October 2020, singly referred to in this Agreement as 'the Party' or jointly as 'the Parties';

The Universidad Autónoma de Madrid, Spain, Public Law institution of the Kingdom of Spain (hereinafter also referred to as UAM), with address at C/Einstein nº 1, Ciudad Universitaria de Cantoblanco 28049 Madrid, Spain, represented by the Vice-Rector for Internationalization, Prof. F. Javier Román González, acting under the delegation of powers granted by Rector's Resolution of July 2nd, 2025 (B.O.C.M July 10th, 2025);

Universidad Complutense de Madrid, Spain, Public Law institution of the Kingdom of Spain (hereinafter also referred to as UCM), with address at Av. Having seen the decisions from the internal administrative bodies that have approved this Agreement at the partner institutions,

The University of Genoa,

Universidad Autónoma de Madrid,

Universidad Complutense de Madrid

Universidad de Alcalá de Henares

Agrees as follows:

Article 1 - Principle

UAM, UCM, UAH and UniGe are setting up a collaboration in the area of Classics studies aimed at launching an integrated and international double Master course named "Máster Universitario en Estudios Clásicos / Laurea magistrale in Filologia e Scienze dell'antichità" (MUEC-FilScAnt]) aiming at awarding the following degrees:

- UniGe: Laurea Magistrale in Filologia e Scienze dell'antichità (LM-15)
- UAM, UCM or UAH: Máster en Estudios Clásicos

At this aim, the students enrolled in the "Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Filologia e scienze dell'antichità" at UniGe that meet the requirements as set out in article 4 of this agreement are admitted to the Course in the "Máster Universitario en Estudios Clásicos at UAM-UCM-UAH.

In the same way, the students enrolled in the "Máster Universitario en Estudios Clásicos" at UAM-UCM-UAH that meet requirements as set out in article 4 of this agreement, are admitted to the "Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Filologia e Scienze dell'antichità" at UNIGE.

The students enrolled in the afore-mentioned courses in the framework of the double Master course must follow a study plan (Annex 1) and coherent with the requirements established.

The double Master course foresees a compulsory mobility period abroad to be carried out at the premises of the other partner institutions.

Article 2 – Duration

This Agreement covers a period of 4 years starting with the academic year 2026/2027 included from the date of signing and shall come into effect upon the signature of the Parties; the date of the last signature thereof taking precedence.

Each Party may terminate the Agreement by serving six months' written notice and supplying adequate motivation for termination. Any activity in progress at the partner Institution at the moment of termination or

expiry of this Agreement shall be completed and students must be given the possibility to conclude their studies.

On termination of this Agreement, the contact names indicated in article 10 shall jointly prepare a report on the activities carried out and the results achieved.

Article 3 – Information about the study plan

Article 4 - Requirements

Students in the framework of this agreement must follow the specific study plan (Annex 1) that is jointly agreed by both the sending and the hosting Institution. This study plan can be modified by the Parties and shall come into force only after the approval of all Institutions.

Candidates for this double degree mobility programme must satisfy the following requirements:

► Students from UNIGE:

A) Students who hold a bachelor's degree and have completed at least 75% of the ECTS established in the first year of the “Laurea Magistrale in Filologia e Scienze dell'antichità” from the University of Genoa.

B) Submit a certificate issued by UNIGE confirming compliance with these requirements.

► Students from UAM, UCM or UAH:


A) Students who have obtained the Degree in Classical and Antique Studies and/or holders of an equivalent diploma as long as they have 240 ECTS recognized and who are enrolled in the “Máster Universitario en Estudios Clásicos” (UAM-UCM-UAH). The first-level degree (Bachelor’s degree) equivalent to 240 CFU/ECTS will be used by UniGe for the purpose of career abbreviation in the Master's program to integrate the 60 CFU/ECTS missing from the Spanish Master's degree for the issuance of the Italian title, in accordance with the criteria outlined in the annex 1D.

B) Submit a certificate issued by UAM, UCM or UAH confirming compliance with these requirements.

The partner institutions agree to admit students with a knowledge of the Spanish and Italian language equal or higher to a B2 level. Students of both Parties are required to have an adequate knowledge of Italian and Spanish, that will be the main languages(s) used during lectures.

In any case, foreign students, who are not EU citizens, will have to comply with the regulations and the deadlines regarding the enrolment established by the Italian Ministry for University and Research (MUR) every year, if requested.

4.1 A Monitoring Committee will be composed of representatives from each party to this agreement. The Committee shall be made up of the coordinators of each Master's program indicated in the tenth clause of this

agreement. These representatives shall ensure compliance with the academic regulations of their respective institutions in the implementation of the program. The responsible coordinators will be the representatives of the training program before external partners. They will also be responsible for coordinating the implementation of a coherent teaching program, the tutoring of students, as well as all matters relating to admission to the program.

4.2 The monitoring committee may, at any time, propose amendments to the terms and conditions of this agreement, which, where applicable, must be approved by each participating university in accordance with its internal regulations.

Article 5 – Selection

Each Academic Year up to 2 students for each University are selected to be admitted in the Double Degree Program “Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Filologia e Scienze dell’antichità” and “Máster Universitario en Estudios Clásicos”.

The coordinators of the Double Master's program will be responsible of the student’s selection process, which will be compliant to the national Spanish and Italian regulations, and according to general criteria such as the academic potential, the linguistic level knowledge, motivation, study records, professional experience and other aspects of the *Curriculum Vitae*.

Article 6 – Mobility period

Student mobility between the Universities is compulsory.

During their mobility period, the students will gain ECTS credits according to the study plan (Annex 1) jointly agreed by both the sending and the hosting Institution. All the parties involved must agree to any modification to it.

The mobility period corresponds to one term (semester), fall or spring period.

Students must provide the host University a transcript of records showing that they passed the required number of credits.

The Grading Table (Annex 2) rules the conversion of the credits obtained by students during the mobility period agreed by both Institutions and updated every year if necessary. The Grading Table is an essential part of this Agreement.

At the beginning of the mobility period, the Monitoring Committee will send each university a detailed credit recognition proposal for each of the students participating in the mobility.

At the end of the mobility period, the hosting Institution must send the student’s home Institution the certificate of attendance as well as the transcript of records reporting the grade obtained for each exam. The recognition of the credits gained by the student during the mobility period is based on the evaluations given by the hosting Institution according to its own rating and evaluation system.

The enrollment of incoming students under the agreement should be shared among all the partner universities. Each university signing the agreement should be responsible for managing the Erasmus agreements that will facilitate the mobility of its own students. Students participating in this double degree may apply for an Erasmus+ grant from their respective home institution within the framework of the Erasmus+ interinstitutional agreements signed. Grants are subject to final selection in the corresponding call and budget availability.

During the exchange period the students, under condition of reciprocity, pay tuition fees and contribution at the home institution and are exempted from tuition fees and contribution at the host university. The fee waiver does not affect any other fees, which are compulsory for all students.

UniGe foresees stamp duties for enrolment and the issue of the Master's Degree diploma.

UAM, UCM and UAH foresee stamp duties for enrolment and the issue of the Master's Degree diploma.

Article 8 – Master thesis

Students enrolled in the double Master degree program will have to prepare only one Master thesis (*tesi di Laurea Magistrale/Trabajo Fin de Máster*) under the direction of a supervisor of the home Institution and under the co-direction of a supervisor of the hosting Institution where the mobility period was carried out. The Master thesis has to be written and discussed in Italian by the Italian students, Spanish by the Spanish students.

Students defend their Master thesis at the home-institution before a committee composed by lecturers from both the home and the hosting Institution.

If requested and agreed, the home-institution can set up a video conference to let the lecturers from the partner Institution participate in the dissertation.

Article 9 – Awarding of the double Master's degree

The awarding of the double Master degree program is approved in accordance with the judgment and evaluation of UAM, UCM, UAH and UniGe provided that the student has met all the requirements, including the mobility period and the defense of the Master thesis. All partner universities will be able to issue the corresponding diploma to enrolled mobility students who have successfully completed the international program. Students will therefore earn two degrees: a Master Universitario en Estudios Clásicos and a Laurea Magistrale in Filologia e Scienze dell'antichità. Each degree will be awarded by the corresponding university.

Article 10 – Coordination

Each partner Institution designates a contact person and an office respectively in charge of the coordination and the management of this Agreement.

Article 11 – Welcome services

At UniGe, the Welcome Office (SASS) offers assistance on the following matters: application for the residence permit, searching for accommodation, application for the Italian fiscal-code, application for the student badge (that allows student the access to many services such as libraries, canteens, etc.), support for health assistance, opening a bank account and getting the bus season ticket.

Moreover, UniGe offers free-of-charge Italian language courses to incoming students.

UAM will provide assistance in finding accommodation, but there are no obligations for participating universities to provide accommodation, and no guarantees can be expected regarding the provision of accommodation by exchange students.

At the UAM, international students can benefit from a reduction in the tuition price of the Spanish course for international students, offered by the Language Service every quarter. This discount is only applicable to the first Spanish as a foreign language course taken by incoming students.

The three Spanish universities will provide incoming students with access to all university libraries (UAM, UCM, UAH).

The UCM will provide assistance in finding accommodation using the information and resources at its disposal, but participating universities are not required to provide accommodation.

At the UCM, Erasmus+ students will receive the same treatment as other incoming students (information on accommodation, intensive Spanish courses, welcome sessions, etc.).

The three Spanish universities belong to the Erasmus Student Network (ESN), whose main objective is to assist all students who come to study and contribute to their integration in their new host city.

Article 12 – Data storage and privacy

The personal data collected under this Agreement will be processed and incorporated into the information management systems for which, where applicable, the signatory parties will be responsible for the purposes of successfully implementing this Agreement. The necessary technical and organizational measures will be adopted to guarantee the security of the personal data provided and prevent its alteration, loss, unauthorized processing, or access, as provided for in both current national regulations, Organic Law 3/2018 (LOPDGDD), the Italian Legislative Decree 101/2018 and the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Both parties expressly declare that they are aware of their obligations to comply with the aforementioned regulations, especially those indicated in relation to the duty to inform the data subjects of their personal data, the duty of secrecy and confidentiality, security measures, data retention for the legally established periods, and the corresponding Agreement to be signed between the data controller and the data processor. The data may be transferred internationally with appropriate security measures and guarantees.

Each party undertakes not to disseminate, transfer, or communicate to other persons, under any circumstances, except as provided by law, the information to which it may have had access during the term of this Agreement. It may apply and use it only for the purpose intended as a result of this Agreement or for its execution, in accordance with the provisions of current national and European personal data protection regulations. This obligation shall continue even after the end of this Agreement.

The data subjects processed in connection with the management and execution of this Agreement may exercise their corresponding rights, and in the case of the University of Alcalá, by writing to the Data Protection Officer (Colegio de San Ildefonso, Plaza de San Diego, s/n. 28801 Alcalá de Henares, Madrid) or by email (protecciondedatos@uah.es), attaching a copy of their ID or equivalent. Both parties agree that the personal data processed as a result of the execution of this Agreement will not be processed for commercial purposes.

Each party shall be responsible for its processing of personal data. Thus, the signatory entities shall be solely liable for any violations they may have incurred due to their failure to comply with the data protection obligations assumed in this Agreement or in the signed Confidentiality Agreement.

Article 13 – Safety and Insurance

All Parties ensure safety and insurance measures as below specified.

About safety in the workplace regarding incoming students and staff involved in the activities established by this Agreement, the hosting University shall conform to applicable European Union legislation.

- UniGE provides mobility students and staff with an insurance coverage for civil liability and accidents. The insurance policy states terms and conditions of the coverage. Students and staff must acquire, at their own expense, an additional insurance policy to be adequately covered, if necessary.

- Before arriving at the host institution, UAM students must take out medical insurance (European Health Card or equivalent) and travel assistance insurance in the host country, which includes private civil liability, medical coverage in case of accident or sudden illness and repatriation of the injured and deceased to Spain. The UAM has reached an agreement with the insurance brokerage OnCampus, which offers travel assistance insurance in the host country at a price below the market to UAM mobility students. In the event that the host institution requires the student to take out a specific insurance policy, the student must follow the instructions of his or her host institution.

- Before arriving at their host institution, UCM students must purchase medical insurance (the European Health Insurance Card or equivalent) and travel assistance insurance in the host country. This insurance includes private civil liability, medical coverage in case of accident or sudden illness, and repatriation of injured or deceased persons to Spain. If the host institution requires students to purchase specific insurance, they must follow the instructions of their host institution.

-At UAH, students are required to have the European Health Insurance Card and private insurance that includes the three coverages not covered by the card: repatriation, accident, and civil liability. Students from outside the European Union must purchase additional insurance that covers the aforementioned. All information regarding insurance can be found at: General Services ([Servicios Generales](#)).

Article 14: Intellectual Property Rights

Each party remains the owner of its prior knowledge. The own results are the property of the party that generated them. The joint results belong jointly to the parties, in proportion to their material, human, intellectual and financial contributions. The conditions of management and exploitation of the joint results shall be formalized by a specific joint ownership agreement concluded by the parties as soon as it is necessary.

Article 15: Violence, Harassment, Discrimination

The undersigned universities undertake to prevent, detect and intervene in any situation of violence, harassment or discrimination based on sex, sexual orientation, gender expression or identity, birth, racial or ethnic origin, religion, conviction or opinion, age, disability, nationality, illness, socioeconomic situation, linguistic, political and union affinity, due to its appearance, or any other personal or social condition or circumstance that may arise within the framework of the mobility Program. The university will act with agility, diligence and impartiality and always respecting the rights of the victims, the duty of confidentiality and the presumption of innocence.

Article 16 Incompatibility

The Parties declare that none of the personnel participating in the activities foreseen by this Agreement find themselves in a situation that might give rise to incompatibility or conflicts of interest pursuant to applicable national legislations and that the related provisions of such legislations shall be respected at all times.

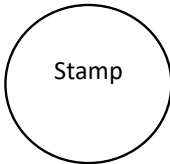

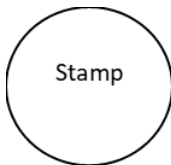
