

## MASTER'S DEGREE IN FACILITY MANAGEMENT IN ARCHITECTURAL HERITAGE

### GENERAL COMPETENCES:

- The student will be able to work and exercise professionally in the field of Integrated Architectural Heritage Management, with a specialized and multidisciplinary carácter.
- The student will be able to integrate the different plans and management systems that make up the Integrated Architectural Heritage Management.

### SPECIFIC COMPETENCES:

- The student will acquire skills and abilities for optimization and rationalization in the use of architectural heritage.
- The student will understand the concept of preventive conservation and be able to draw up conservation and maintenance plans and oversee their implementation.
- The student will be able to handle the different plans, documents, methodologies or computer programs that are of potential use in the field of management for the enhancement of architectural heritage.
- The student will be able to use information management systems.
- The student will acquire the ability to analyse the possible services to be provided with an adequate cost/quality balance.
- The student will have the ability to optimize the exploitation of the heritage under his/her management.
- The student will be able to establish a global process of risk management, identifying, analysing and evaluating the potential risks that can occur when exploiting the architectural heritage.
- The student will be able to plan environmental management processes applied to heritage, evaluate their efficiency and costs.
- The student will be able to elaborate energy audits in historical buildings, analyse them and establish correction systems for their optimal management.
- The student will be able to draw up integrated management plans for service in the operation of architectural heritage.
- The student will be able to use the different service management systems of application in real estate.
- The student will be able to write the conditions for the contracting of different services in his/her sphere of management.
