The teaching methodology and strategies have been changed according to the new conditions. All activities have been carried out online, both theoretical lessons and practical ones too (problem solving and lab projects work)

## 3. ASSESSMENT: PROCEDURES, ASSESSMENT AND QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

**Yes**, some changes/adaptations have been made to this section:

The lab weight in the global course score is kept. The weight of the removed lab project has been distributed among the rest of them assigning 1 point to each one (from a global score of 10 points). In order to pass the lab, the total score of the lab projects set must be equal or greater than the 30 % of the maximum achievable lab score. Regarding theoretical contents assessment: there will be an intermediate examination before 25th of May having 35 % weight of the full score, covering units 1 and 2 (out of 4 units of the full program). In order to free contents a minimum of 45 % of the total exam weight must be obtained in the marks of this exam. In the final exam date, another exam covering units 3 and 4 will be done, with a 35 % weight. To free contents with this exam a minimum of a 45 % of the full achievable score must

be obtained. Also, in the final exam date, a recovery test corresponding to the units 1 and 2 examined in the previous intermediate test will be done. In this test, to free its contents, a minimum mark corresponding to the 45 % of its total score must be obtained.

All exams will be carried out online by means of MCQs, encompassing all the units studied along the course.
